Platform Goals

- Apply lessons learned
- Provide more flexibility for content modeling
- More optional modules
- Reduce number of completely custom sites
- Improve editorial UX
- Automated test suite
- Accessible from the start
- Clean, documented code (reduce tech debt)

Local Development

- Docker-based
- Not using a docker wrapper (dosksal, lando)
- NFS for faster file performance
- Common env for everyone
- Still not ideal



Automated Testing

- Pros:
 - Big wins for catching regressions
 - Peace of mind
- Cons
 - Slows development
 - Refactoring tests required
 - Slow to run
